



***City of Pleasant Valley Missouri
Meeting of the Board of Aldermen
August 29, 2018
Public Hearing***

Call to Order: The Pleasant Valley Board of Aldermen held the annual tax levy public hearing. The meeting was called to order at City Hall, 6500 Royal, Pleasant Valley, Clay County, Missouri, by Mayor David Slater, on Wednesday, August 29, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. The City Clerk provided copies of the proposed tax levy information, public notices and ordinance, for the public prior to the meeting.

Roll Call: Present were: Mayor David Slater, Alderman Loren Jones, Alderwoman Mary Langner, Alderman Jim Menaugh, Alderwoman Ruth Mesimer, Alderman Rick Scarborough, and Alderman James Smith. Alderman Anthony Crawford and Alderwoman Linda Jacoby were absent.

Staff present: City Clerk Georgia Fox.

Public Comments: No one from the public wished to discuss the proposed tax levy. The 2018 proposed tax levy rate is \$0.7160, the same rate as last year.

However, Dustin Draper, who lives on Fulton Road, was present to discuss concerns about the culverts and storm water drainage on Fulton Road. Mayor Slater said that the 2018 Storm Water Master Plan will be taken up at a regular meeting soon. The City is waiting on the City Engineer to submit the finalized plan. The City Clerk will contact Mr. Draper when it is put on the agenda so he can attend the meeting.

Mayor Comments: Mayor Slater said that if the use tax issue passes the City should consider allocating some of the revenue towards curb and gutter improvements annually.

Mayor Slater also noted that the valuations were slightly higher than last year.

Aldermen Comments: There were no aldermen comments.

Adjournment of Public Hearing: Since there was no one else from the public who wished to discuss the proposed tax levy, Alderwoman Mesimer moved to adjourn. Alderman Smith seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Crawford – absent, Jacoby – absent, Jones – aye, Langner – aye, Menaugh – aye, Mesimer – aye, Scarborough – aye, Smith – aye. Motion passed. 7:05pm.
