Work will cause ramp closure on I-35 in Clay County

CLAY COUNTY – Crews for the Missouri Department of Transportation will close the ramp from southbound I-35 to Pleasant Valley Rd. from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, April 22, and again Sunday, April 23, for retaining wall work.

This is all part of an effort to improve Interstate 35 from Vivion Rd. to Pleasant Valley Rd., including the Pleasant Valley Interchange, Church Rd., Sobbie Rd., Pleasant Valley Rd. and US 69.

All work is weather dependent.

Motorists are reminded to slow down and pay attention while driving in work zones. Not all work zones look alike. Work zones can be moving operations, such as striping, patching or mowing. They can also be short term, temporary lane closures to make quick repairs or remove debris from the roadway.
